All competitions must be recorded with the ASHA in order to post show records (including points for KSF/WCHS Qualifying, CH, CH-EQ, National Pleasure, and ASHA High Point). **This form must be received by the ASHA at least 2 weeks prior to your show's dates.**

Benefits to recording your competition with the ASHA include:

- Your exhibitors' results will count toward all WCHS and ASHA point system programs (must be current ASHA competing member).
- Results will be included on the individual horses' competition records on the ASHA Web site.
- **Free listing in the Competition Search on the ASHA Web site for recorded shows.**

NOTE: If multiple judges are used for multiple results, one judge must be designated by competition management prior to the competition being held. The designated judge's results will be the only results used on horses' records. This is not applicable to competitions that use a three-judge panel for a single set of results.

As an authorized representative of the above named competition, USEF or OPEN SHOWS, I agree to:

- Submit a copy of the prize list to the ASHA as soon as it becomes available. If available online or electronically, hard copy is not required.
- Results SHOULD include: (download template at https://www.asha.net/media/1241/_resultstemplate_forshows.xls)
 1. Complete class listings that include all names of horses with the American Saddlebred registration #s. shown and judged. not just ribbon winners.
 2. Names and ASHA Membership #s of all owners, riders/drivers/handlers and trainers. Beginning with the 2019 competition year - Owners, riders, drivers, handlers and trainers of American Saddlebred horses showing at USEF licensed competitions and open horse shows recorded with ASHA, who are not current ASHA competing members, will not have points counted for KSF/WCHS Qualifying, National Pleasure and ASHA High Point Awards.
- **Results MUST be submitted to the ASHA within ten (10) days of the last day of the competition.**

ASHA Policy (approved by ASHA Board of Directors on 2/4/19)

Effective February 4, 2019, the ASHA will not record any show results for any person that appears on the Safe Sport or USEF banned or suspended lists (<https://www.usef.org/compete/resources/forms/rules-regulations/suspension-list>). These individuals cannot be in attendance, compete or participate in such competition in any manner, including as a trainer, coach, owner, or exhibitor of horses or ponies. The foregoing Policy is in compliance with the Memorandum of Understanding that has been entered into between the USEF and the ASHA as the recognized American Saddlebred Affiliate of the USEF.
