Breeders Committee Charter

Definition

The Breeders Committee supports the mission of the American Saddlebred Horse and Breeders Association (ASHBA) by promoting interest in all matters pertaining to breeding, including increasing the number of American Saddlebreds being bred each year.

The primary responsibilities of the Breeders Committee are to:

1. Advise ASHBA on ways to keep current breeders interested in continuing to breed American Saddlebreds.
2. Advise ASHBA on ways to encourage members and others involved in the industry that are not involved in breeding to breed American Saddlebreds.
3. Advise ASHBA on ways to encourage those outside our industry to breed American Saddlebreds.

Meetings

The Breeders Committee meets on a monthly basis. Additional meetings may be scheduled on an as needed basis.

1. Assist in developing programs to support current breeders and encourage them to continue to breed.
2. Assist in developing programs to encourage members who are not currently involved in breeding to breed.
3. Collect data pertaining to the breeding of American Saddlebreds including but not limited to: demographics, program size, and issues facing the breeding industry.
