Standards & Rules Committee Charter

Definition

The Standards & Rules Committee receives, reviews, and recommends proposed amendments for American Saddlebred Horse divisions and disciplines prior to proposal to USEF. Members of the committee are appointed by the President of the Board and are accountable to the Board of Directors (BOD) of the American Saddlebred Horse and Breeders Association (ASHBA). This is a standing committee per ASHBA bylaws.

Meetings

The Standards & Rules committee shall meet as least annually, and as needed.
