Registry Rules Committee

Definition

The Registry Rules Committee is responsible for Registry rule interpretation and enforcement. Members of this committee are appointed by the Registry Council and are accountable to the Registry Council. This is a standing Registry Council committee per the American Saddlebred Horse and Breeders Association (ASHBA) bylaws

Following are the primary responsibilities of the Committee:

1. Review Registry related Bylaw amendments and rule changes proposed by the Registry Council, the Committee, members, staff, and others before presentation to the Registry Council for consideration.
2. Review case and interpret Registry rules as they apply to Registry transactions and other matters.
3. Act as a review/hearing Committee for Registry rule alleged infractions.
4. Review rules to approve Registry registration of foreign horses.
5. Assist Registrar with interpretation and application of rules and policies.

Meetings

The Registry Rules Committee meets on an as needed basis.
